Make communications multilingual and accessible!

Publish on pre-print servers (e.g. arXiv, bioRxiv)
Publish manuscripts in open access journals
Translate research paper abstracts
Translate software documentation
Subtitle and/or transcribe recordings
Use alternative text features to describe visual communications

Make data FAIR!

Findable: Use persistent,
machine-readable metadata
Accessible: Can be read via
free and open software
Interoperable: Should be
readable without specialized
translation or algorithms
Reusable: Metadata and data
should be well-described so it
can be replicated
